The Live component

ARCHES is an immersive musical event that seamlessly blends a guided tour of a building with an exceptional classical music concert.

Depending on the venue, the audience is invited to explore the building, interact with singers and musicians, or remain seated as the artists move through the space.

Lasting for 60 minutes, ARCHES provides an organic experience of sound, music, architecture, and history.
